Dear Sir:

Reference is made to your letter of April 8, 1960, wherein you request an exception to the no-flare order for the Gallegos-Gallup Oil Pool, San Juan County, for your Roberson "A" Well No. 4, located in Unit O of Section 25, Township 27 North, Range 13 West.

Prior to issuing any exception to the no-flare order this office must have certain information relative to the need thereof.

Please furnish us with evidence that it is uneconomic to connect this well. This evidence most usually consists of a letter from the nearest low pressure casing head gas purchaser, analyzing the amount of gas which is available, the cost of laying the line and other gathering facilities, and the length of time required to pay such a connection out.

Upon receipt of information of this type, the Commission will be in a position to consider your request for an exception to the no-flare order.

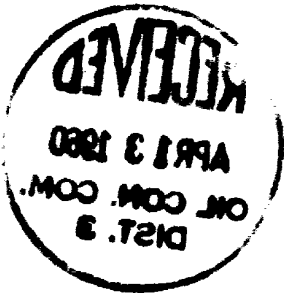

Dear Sir:

Reference is made to your letter of April 8, 1960, wherein you request an exception to the no state order for the Gallegos Canyon Oil Field, San Juan County, for your Robertson "A" Well No. 4, located in the NE 1/4 of Section 25, Township 27 North, Range 13 West.

First to be made any exception to the no state order this office must have been furnished with evidence relative to the need therefor.

As stated in the letter, evidence must be submitted to the Commission in the form of a well log. This evidence must usually consist of a letter from the nearest low pressure casing head gas purchaser, analyzing the gas which is available, the cost of laying the line and other gathering facilities, and the length of time required to pay such a well out.

Upon receipt of information of this type, the Commission will be in a position to consider your request for an exception to the no state order.
