
Pursuant to our telephone conversation of September 9, 1964, I hereby request that R & G Gas Well Number 40 Hammond (Pictured Cliffs, Southeast Quarter of Section 26, Township 27 North, Range 8 West) be released from shut-in for over production for such period as is necessary to conduct a deliverability test; such test to be applicable in the computation of allowables for the current year. This request is made in view of the fact that the erroneous deliverability test currently effective (443 mcf) was made retroactive by the Commission, resulting in an exaggerated over-produced status causing the well to be shut in for the entire calendar year and still carried as some 25,000 mcf over produced.

As a matter of fact, the deliverability of this well is more nearly 1,000 mcf than the currently effective figure.

Please see that we are permitted an early retest of this well; such test results to be applicable for the entire calendar year. A procedure that would no doubt erase its over-produced status and permit its equitable production.
