As a result of the Gallup production on this doubly completed well declining to uneconomical rates, and due to compressor failure and no-flow order, the Angels Peak Gallup horizon was temporarily abandoned February, 1966 by shutting in the Gallup tubing. We plan to pull rods and tubing and load the Bakota tubing-casing annulus with corrosion inhibitor fluid. Production from the Basin Bakota horizon is being continued.
