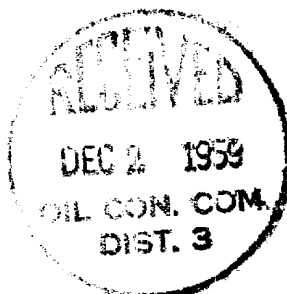


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THE APPLICATION OF PAN AMERICAN

DAKOTA POOL.

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A (c) Pan American Petroleum Corporation made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on November 4, 1959, for permission to dually complete its Jack Frost "B" Well No. 1, located in the SE/4 SE/4 of Section 27, Township 27 North, Range 10 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of oil from the Angels Peak-Gallup Oil Pool and the production of gas from the Angels Peak-Dakota Pool.

Now, on this 24th day of November, 1959, the Secretary-Director finds:

(1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Sub-section 'c' of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;

(2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and

(3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.

(4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.

(5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Pan American Petroleum Corporation, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Jack Frost "B" Well No. 1, located in the SE/4 SE/4 of Section 27, Township 27 North, Range 10 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of oil from the Angels Peak-Gallup Oil Pool and the production of gas from the Angels Peak-Dakota Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Section V, Rule 112-A, as amended by Order R-1214.

**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION**

Under the provisions of Rule 11-A (c) Pan American Petroleum
Corporation made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission
on November 24, 1957, for permission to drill its Jack I Rose "1"
Well No. 1, located in the SE 1/4 of Section 17, Township 23 North, Range
10 West, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit
the production of oil from the Angels Peak-Galup Oil Field and the production
of gas from the Angels Peak-Del Norte Pool.

Now, on this 24th day of November, 1957, the Secretary directs
that:

(1) That application has been filed under the provisions
of Rule 11-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations.

(2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all
operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and

(3) That no objections have been received within the waiting
period as prescribed by said rules.

(4) That the proposed dual competition will not cause waste in
the oil-bearing strata.

(5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual competition are
consistent and in accordance with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Pan American Petroleum Corporation,
be and the same is hereby authorized to drill its Jack I Rose "1"
Well No. 1, located in the SE 1/4 of Section 17, Township 23 North, Range
10 West, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit
the production of oil from the Angels Peak-Galup Oil Field and the production
of gas from the Angels Peak-Del Norte Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall comply, operate,
and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Section V, Rule
11-A, as amended by Order R-1514.

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PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the Angels Peak-Dakota Pool.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained by the Commission for such further order or orders as may seem necessary or convenient for the prevention of waste and/or protection of correlative rights; upon failure of applicant to comply with any requirement of this order after proper notice and hearing the Commission may terminate the authority hereby granted and require applicant or its successors and assigns to limit its activities to regular single-zone production in the interests of conservation.
