

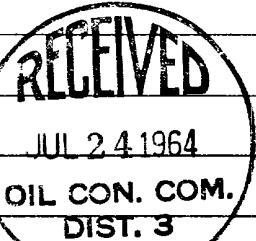

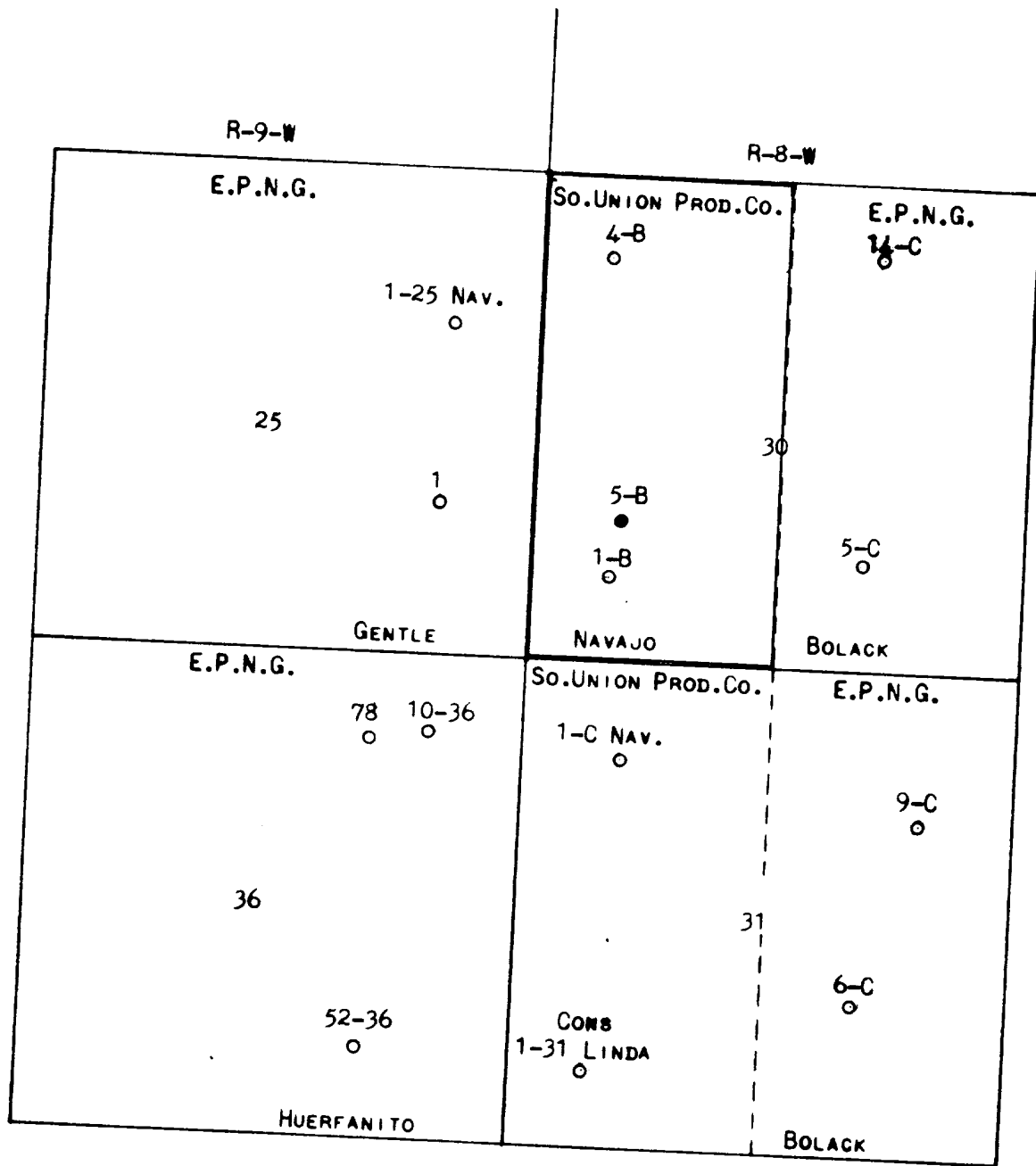

NAVAJO INDIAN #5-B

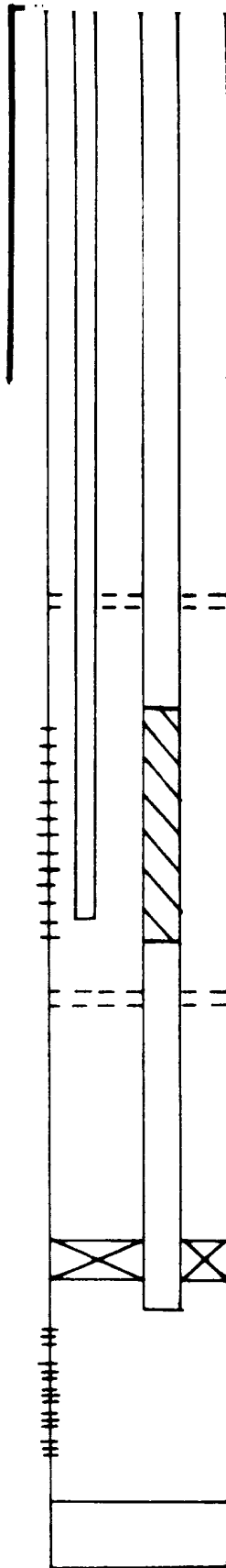
