A copy of this letter is being sent to our Astec, New Mexico office in whose district the location will be produced.

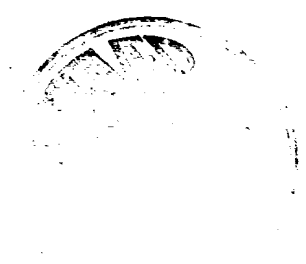


