Enclosed is a rough plat of Sec. 26, T 27 N - R II W, where the Hancock Oil Co. have made a location to drill a well which will probably go to the Dakota sands which in this area will probably be around 6500 feet.

Owing to the proximity of the pipe line they wish to move this location 200 feet to the west and when they make their formal application in my opinion they should be allowed to do so.

660' From the North line and
1780' from the West line of
Sec. 26, T 27 N - R II West.
