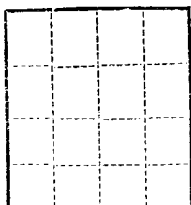

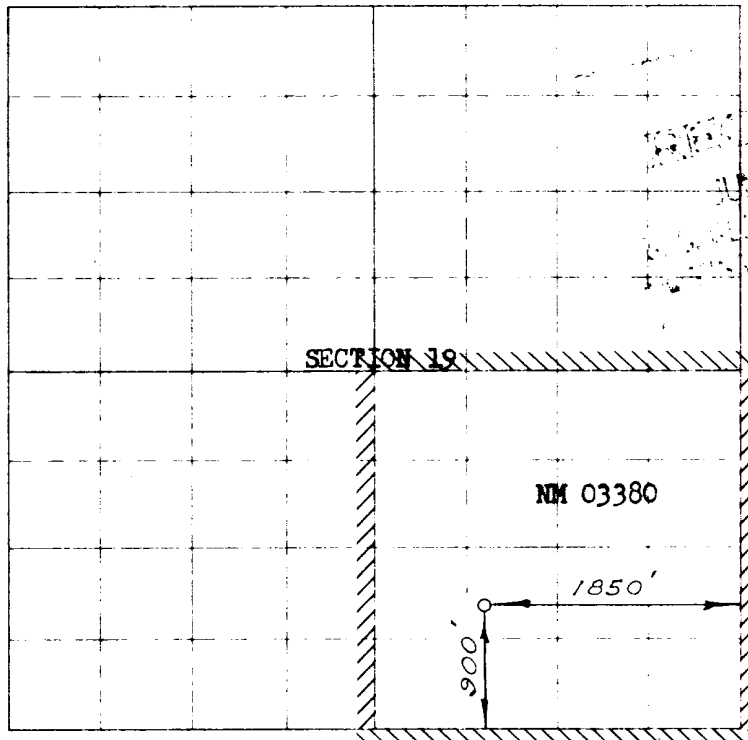
WELL LOCATION AND OR GAS PRODUCTION PLAT
