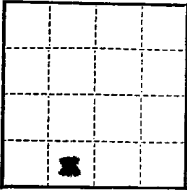

DETAILS OF WORK

We propose to drill this well to 5,500 to test the Gallup sand expected at 5100'.

We will set 10 3/4" casing to approximately 250' with sufficient cement to circulate.

We will set 7" casing to 3300' with sufficient cement to place the top 900' above the zones to be tested.

The casing will be gun perforated and the formation fraced during completion.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

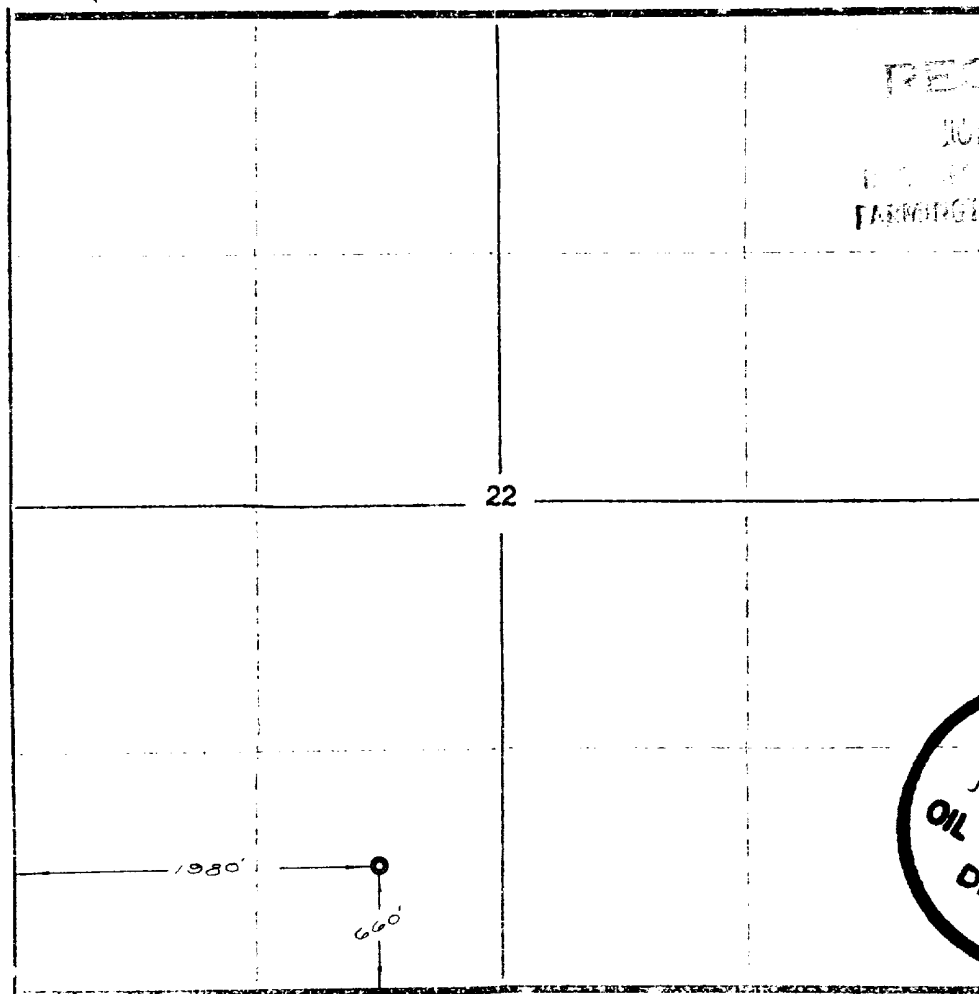
