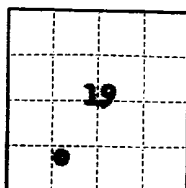

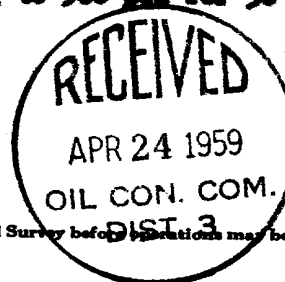

DETAILS OF WORK

- Spudded well March 31, 1959
- Ran 4 joints 10-3/4", H-40, 32.75' surface casing on April 1, 1959. Landed at 124' R.K.B. Cemented w/150 sacks cement w/2% calcium chloride.
- Drilled plug and pressured up on surface casing to 500 psi for 30 minutes on April 2, 1959. Pressure held.
