DETAILS OF WORK

Drilled 8-3/4" hole to 6540' and cemented 6528' of 5-1/2" O.D. casing at 6539' in two stages with Baker two-stage tool set at 1903'. Cemented casing with 300 sacks of cement during first stage of cement job with top of cement 5420' and cement plug at 6505'. Cemented casing from 1382' to 1903' with 200 sacks of cement during second stage of cement job. Tested casing with 1000# pressure for 30 minutes. Tested O.K.
