
Reference is made to your application dated August 16, 1990 for a non-standard Basin-Fruitland coal gas well location for your existing Cleveland Well No. 7 which was drilled in 1955 and completed in the Fulcher Kutz Pictured Cliffs Pool at a standard gas well location 1650 feet from the South and East lines (Unit J) of Section 21, Township 27 North, Range 9 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico.

J - 21 - 27 N. 9 W

It is my understanding that the Pictured Cliffs zone will be properly plugged back and said well will be recompleted to the Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool, which pursuant to the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, is unorthodox. Further, the S/2 of said Section 21 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.


By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 8 of said Division Order No. R-8768, the above-described unorthodox coal gas well location is hereby approved.




