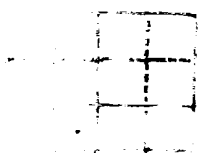

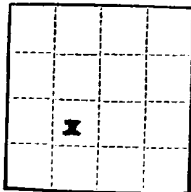

DETAILS OF WORK

Propose to run 2 1/2" hole, 200 ft. well with 2 1/2" hole to the top of the Pictured Cliffs formation. Expected bottom, 1,900 feet and 1,400 feet below surface. Sample for oil, gas, and sand and shale. Also shooting with well fluid as described in work.

Casing program: 20 feet of 2 1/2" hole and 2 1/2" hole. Also casing to surface, using at least 1/4" steel at bottom.

5-1/2" O.P. 11 1/2" hole. Also casing to top of Pictured Cliffs formation and cemented with 100 sacks of cement.

1" casing to surface. Also casing to top of Pictured Cliffs formation.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

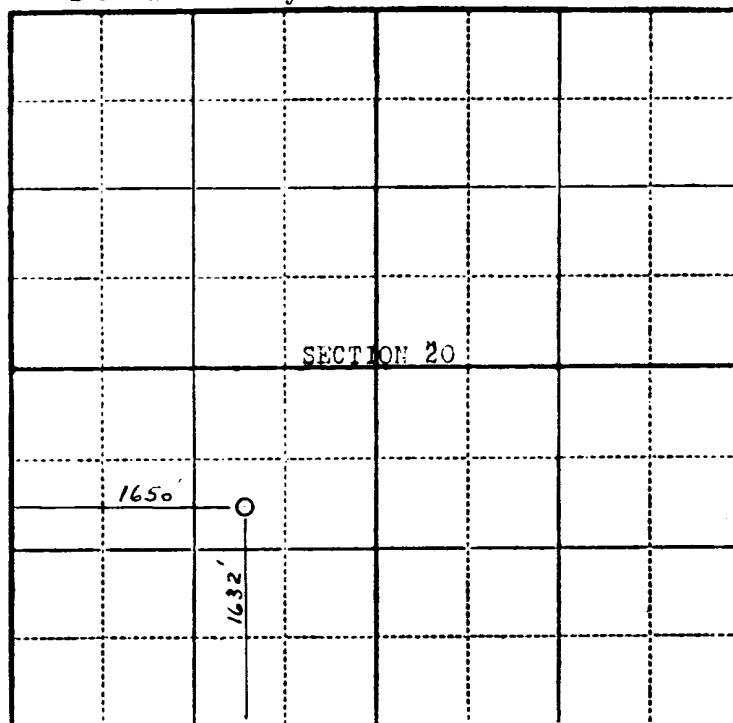
