The elevation of the derrick floor above sea level is 6232 ft. (C.L.)

DETAILS OF WORK

Well was drilled to a total depth of 2135 feet with rotary tools. Cable tool rig moved onto well and cleaned out to bottom.

Well was plugged back with pea gravel from 2210 to 2150 feet and shot with 333 quarts of SAG from 2150' to 2082' with gravel tamp 2082'-2077' and Cal-seal cap 2077'-2036 on top of shot as of September 12th, 1951. Well was cleaned out to bottom. 1" tubing was landed at 2158 feet.

Well was shut in for 72 hours. Shut in casing pressure 305. After blowing through 2" casing outlet for 3 hours well measured 887 MCF per day with pitot tube, October 1, 1951. Well shut in for pipe line connection.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
