DETAILS OF WORK

1. Hole cleaned out to 2095' KB ED on 7/26/51.
2. Ran 7 shells 4 x 20 or 140 quarts of liquid nitro and dumped 120 quarts of jallied nitro (280 quarts total) from 2013-2091' (datum on valve 4' above ground).
3. Filled hole to 2080' with pea gravel.
4. Dumped Cal Seal to 1973' KB. Shot off at 4:15 A.M. 7/27/51.
5. Cleaned out hole to 2090' after shot. Ran 2029' of 1" ciphon line set at 2036' KB and completed on 7/28/51.
6. Gaged 500 MCFFD at 460' SIP with some moisture.
