1. Spudded 5/16/51.
2. Set 75' 9-5/8" OD, 8rd. thd., 29.3#/ft. casing at 100' KB with 100 sacks of regular cement and circulated to surface.
3. Tested casing with 500# pressure held for 30 minutes prior to drilling plug and showed no drop in pressure.
4. After drilling plug, tested for 30 minutes with 300#. The water level remained stationary.
