MIRUSU 12/22/94. Tag at 2753 ft - bottom of perf. Called BLM 12/23/94 at 10:20 am, talked to J. Morrison about not being able to put in cement plug 2843-2753 due to fill, advise we continue with P&A procedure.

Plugback 2593-2590 ft with cement retainer.

Squeeze 2753-2644 ft with 26 sx Class B 65/35 poz, 14.0 ppg.

Plugback 2753-2593 ft with 30 sx of Class B 65/35 cement, 2% gel.

Plugback 2590-800 ft with 328 sx of Class B cement, 65/35 poz with 2% gel.

Perforated 800-801 with 2 JSPF. Attempted to circulate from 800 ft - wouldn't circulate. Perforated 224-225 ft with 2 JSPF. Circulated to surface.

Squeeze 224-0 ft with 48 sx Class B neat, 15.6 ppg, avg rate 1.0 bpm, max rate 2.5 bpm.

Plugback 224-0 ft with 44 sx of Class B neat cement. Cut off wellhead, install marker. RDMOSU 12/16/94.

Reference is made to your well No. 4 Florance D LS, 1840' FNL & 1800' FEL Sec. 20, T. 27 N., R. 8 W., San Juan County, New Mexico, Lease NMNM-03380. The subject well was approved for long term shut in until June 1, 1995. The subject well was shut in due to possibility of using the well in a future nitrogen injection project. To date, we have not received your plans for the above-mentioned well.

You have 30 days to comply with this order. The 30 days commences upon receipt of this letter or seven days from the date it is mailed, whichever is less. Failure to comply within the 30 days will result in strict enforcement of 43 CFR 3163.1.

Under provisions of 43 CFR 3165.3, you may request an Administrative Review of the orders described above. Such requests, including all supporting documents, must be filed in writing within 20 business days of receipt of this notice and must be filed with the State Director, Bureau of Land Management, P. O. Box 27115, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87504-0115. Such requests shall not result in a suspension of the orders unless the reviewing official so determines. Procedures governing appeals from instructions, orders or decisions are contained in 43 CFR 3165.4 and 43 CFR 4.400 *et seq.*
