Dear Bud:

New Mexico Oil Conservation Order R-8952 (for the protection of migratory birds) became effective June 15, 1989 and states that <u>all pits</u> and open tanks more than 16' in diameter shall be screened, netted or covered.

Field inspections conducted by Jackie Neckels/BLM on August 18, 1993 revealed that the above mentioned pit was 3/4 full of water with an oil skim. In order for this pit to be in compliance, you are hereby directed to remove all fluid or properly net this pit by December 29, 1993.
