Casing program is as follows:

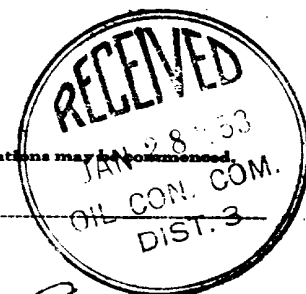
150' of 13-3/8" OD 48# H-40 to be cemented with 150 sacks of regular cement.

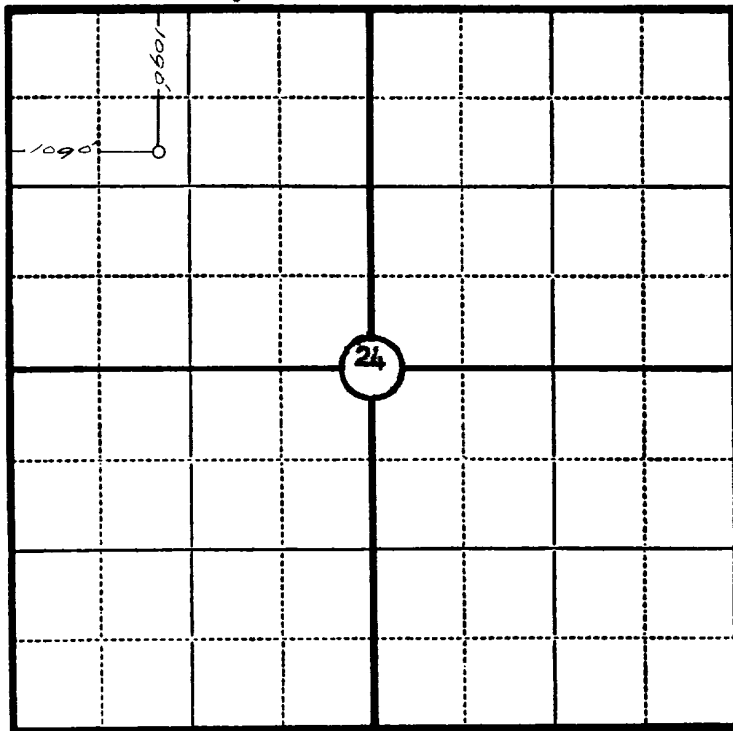
