## Dear Ms. Bradfield:

Reference is made to your application dated October 2, 1990 for a non-standard Basin-Fruitland coal gas well location for your existing Navajo Indian "B" Well No. 2 which was drilled in 1959 and completed in the South Blanco Pictured Cliffs Pool at a standard gas well location 990 feet from the North and West lines (Unit D) of Section 19, Township 27 North, Range 8 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico.

It is my understanding that the Pictured Cliffs zone will be properly plugged back and said well will be recompleted to the Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool, which pursuant to the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, is unorthodox. Further, Lots 1 through 4 and the E/2 W/2 (W/2 equivalent) of said Section 19 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 321.44-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 8 of said Division Order No. R-8768, the above-described unorthodox coal gas well location is hereby approved.
