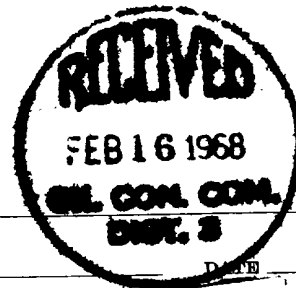

This well was spudded 10/8/64 and plugged and abandoned 11/18/64. Drilled to a total depth of 7095'. 9-5/8" OD 32.30# 8-KT R-40 R-2 SS csg. ST&C set at 777' - still in well.

Amerada plans to move in rotary tools 2/26/68, drill out cement plugs, and clean out hole to 7095', run 4 1/2" OD 10.50# & 11.60# J-55 R-2 SS csg. to 7090'.

Tentative plans are: Perforate from 7736-7772', wash with mud acid and snub test. There is a possibility we might try a sand-water frac through above perfor. Perforate from 7702-7000', wash with mud acid and snub test. Perforate from 7400-7310', wash with mud acid and snub test. Perforate from 7350-7301', wash with mud acid and snub test. Perforate from 7060-7104', wash with mud acid and snub test.

If we find a commercial amount of helium in this well, we will complete well as a helium gas well.

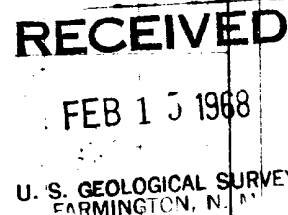
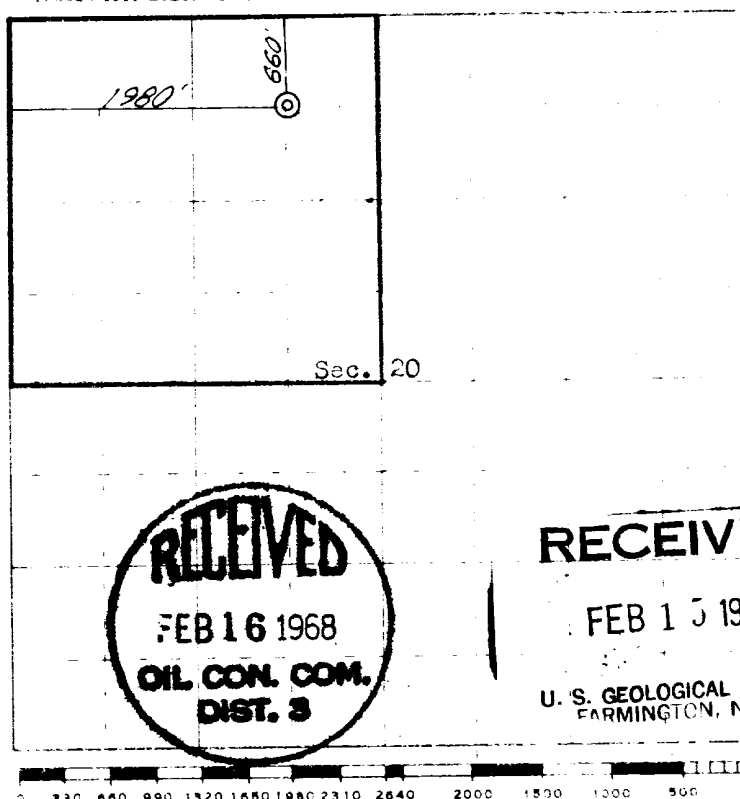
