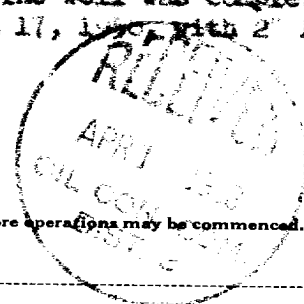

DETAILS OF WORK

It was originally intended to drill and complete this well in the Mesa Verde formation only. On the basis of the electrical log of this well and initial potentials of nearby Pictured Cliffs wells, it was subsequently decided to dually complete this well in the Mesa Verde and Pictured Cliffs formations. However, the Pictured Cliffs formation failed to respond to stimulative treatment and was found to be non-commercial. On March 12-13, 1955, the Pictured Cliffs perforations at 2870-2950 were squeezed off with 200 sacks of cement. The well was completed in the Mesa Verde formation as originally planned on March 17, 1955 with 2" AUC tubing landed at 5304'.
