Dear Mr. Arnold:

This is to notify you of a change in dual completion plans. The El Paso Natural Gas Company Florance No. 10-D (PM) well is located 790 feet from the North line and 1650 feet from the East line of Section 17, Township 27 North, Range 8 West, N.M.P.M., San Juan County, New Mexico.

The well, originally scheduled to be completed in the Mesa Verde formation only, was offset by several Pictured Cliffs wells having high initial potentials. On the basis of this and information obtained from the electrical logs, it was decided on March 6, 1958 to attempt to dually complete the well in the Mesa Verde and Pictured Cliffs formations.

However, the Pictured Cliffs formation did not respond to stimulative treatment and was found to be non-commercial. The Pictured Cliffs perforations at 2878-2950 were then squeezed off with 200 sacks of cement, and the well was subsequently completed in the Mesa Verde formation only.
