**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION**

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A (c), Skelly Oil Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on July 5, 1960 for permission to dually complete its John Charles Well No. 7, located in the SE/4 SW/4 of Section 13, Township 27 North, Range 9 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the Mesaverde formation adjacent to the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool and the production of gas from an undesignated Dakota Pool.

NOW, on this 25th day of July, 1960, the Secretary-Director finds:

(1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Subsection 'c' of Rule 112-A of the Commission Rules and Regulations;

(2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and

(3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.

(4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.

(5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

That the applicant herein, Skelly Oil Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its John Charles Well No. 7, located in the SE/4 SE/4 of Section 13, Township 27 North, Range 9 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the Mesaverde formation adjacent to the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool and the production of gas from an undesignated Dakota Pool, through parallel strings of tubing.

**PROVIDED HOWEVER,** That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Section V, Rule 112-A.

**PROVIDED FURTHER,** That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool.
