2- #C's series GWS

This well is the Dakota (6443) #1-13. It is a Dakota Gas test and will be drilled to approximately 7000'. 8 5/8" surface casing will be set at 325' and cemented full length. Production casing will be 4 1/2", set thru the lower most productive sand. The casing will be cemented in three stages. First stage thru shoe second stage thru collar 50' below Mesa Verde and third stage thru collar 50' below Pictured Cliffs. Water will be used as drilling fluid to 1000' and then mud will be used to total depth.

Instructions

Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 1: If the proposal is to redrill to the same reservoir at a different subsurface location or to a new reservoir, use this form with appropriate notations. Consult applicable State or Federal regulations concerning subsequent work proposals or reports on the well.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

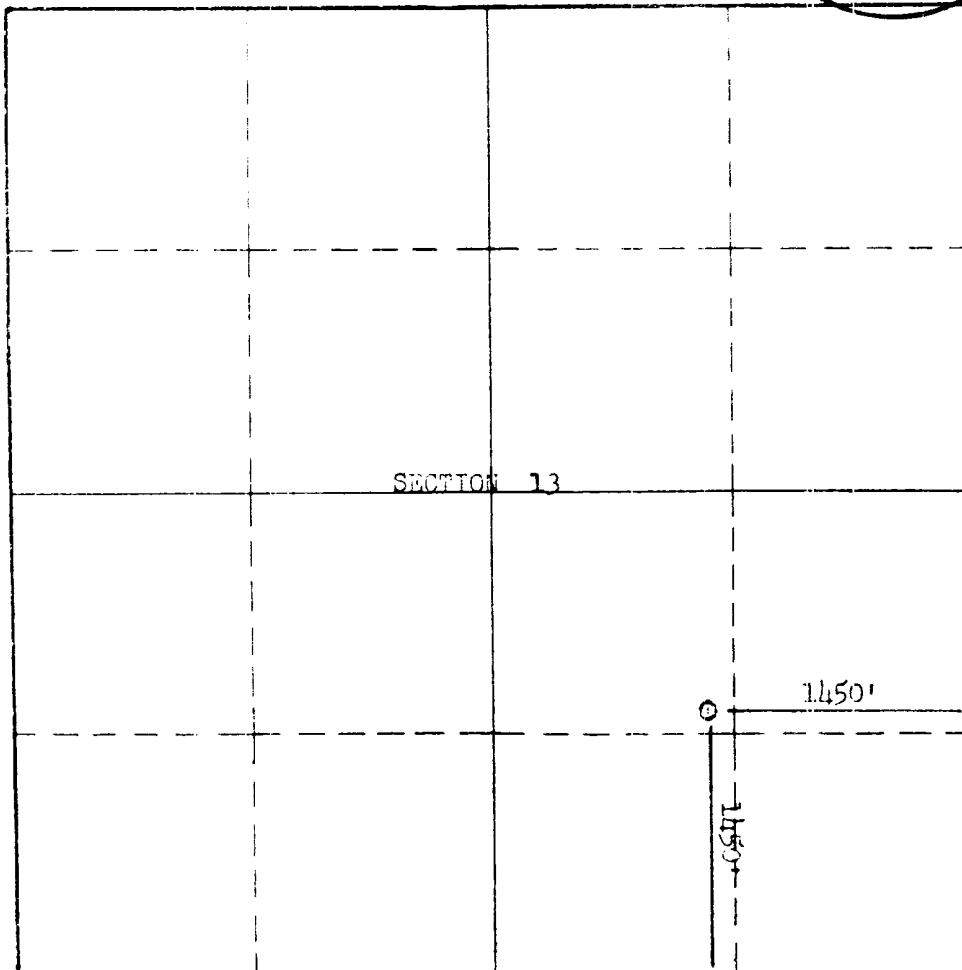
