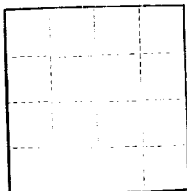

It is our intention to drill Well No. 1 to approximately 44' to test the pictured Cliffs formation. Our casing program is as follows:

15' 1 1/2" OD casing, 32.75 lb. M-40, to be cemented with 150 lbs. regular cement, to be circulated.

24' 3 1/2" OD casing, 25 lb. M-55, cemented with 150 lbs. cement.

The designated drilling unit is the 15' 1/2" of section 14-7-9, San Juan County, New Mexico.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

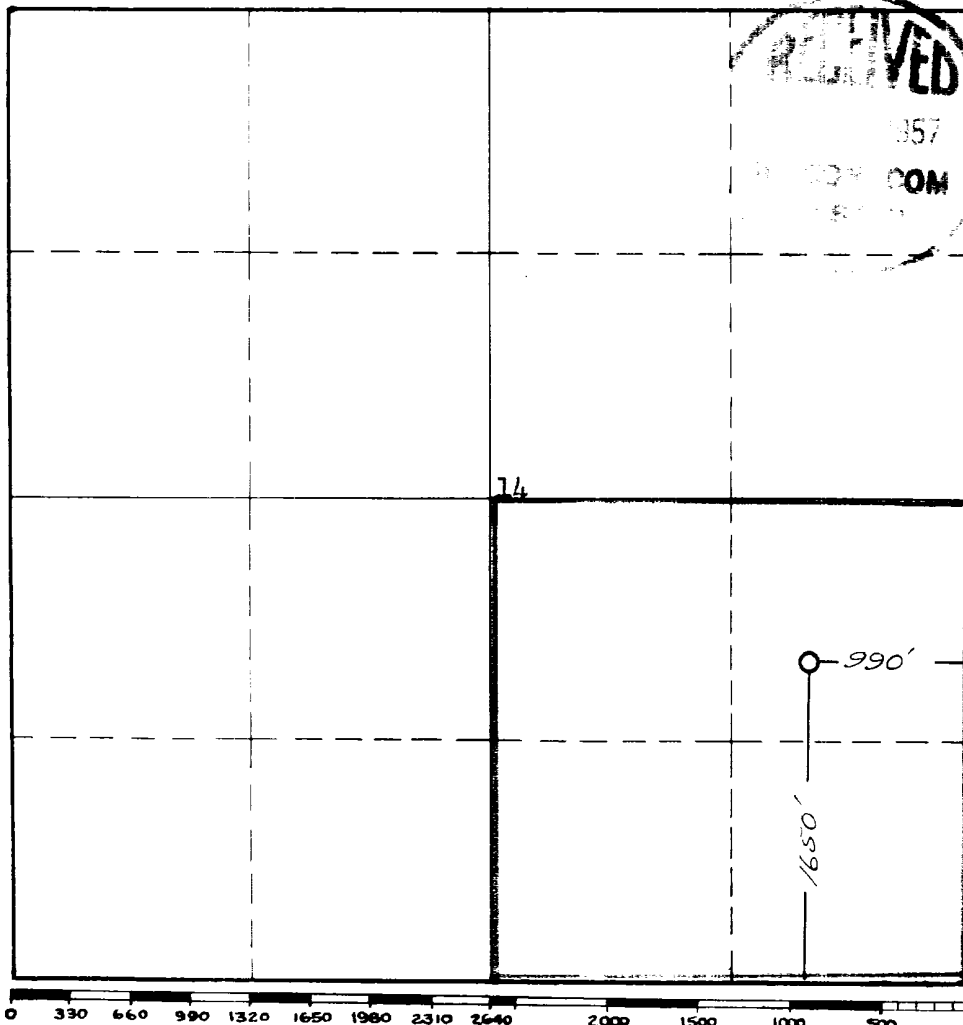
