DETAILS OF WORK

- On 12/31/51 ran 62 joints or 2029' of 5 1/2" OD, Std. Wt., 14-l casing set at 2005' TD with 130 sacks of regular cement. Casing in hole is 2005'. Plug down at 8:00 P.M.
- Moved off rotary tools.
- Moved in cable tools on 1/8/52.
- Drilled thru plug on 1/9/52 and baled hole dry down to casing shoe. Hole stood dry for 30 minutes.
- Drilled to 2012' TD (7).
