

Dear Sir:

Stanolind Oil and Gas Company, operating under a certain oil and gas lease covering Federal Lands situated in the SW/4, Section 14, T-27-N, R-10-W, Fulcher-Kutz Field, San Juan County, New Mexico, proposes to drill a well to the Pictured Cliffs Formation for development of gas on the above captioned quarter section as a designated unit.

Angel Peak occupies a portion of the SW/4 of Section 14 and the extremely rough terrain precludes the possibility of building roads and levelling the location suitable for a drill site at any of the regular locations falling within the prescribed spacing pattern for the Fulcher-Kuts Field. We, therefore, find it necessary for tepographical reasons to locate a well in this quarter section at an unorthodox location. We have had this quarter section surveyed and find a reasonably suitable drill site at 1650' from the South line and 2310' from the West line of Section 14. We, therefore, respectfully request approval to drill a well to be known as Stanolind Oil and Gas Company's Eva E. Martin "A" #1 located 1650' from the South line and 2310' from the West line of Section 14, T-27-N, R-10-W, Fulcher-Kuts Field, San Juan County, New Mexico.

A surveyor's plat of Section 14 depicting the subject location is herete attached.
