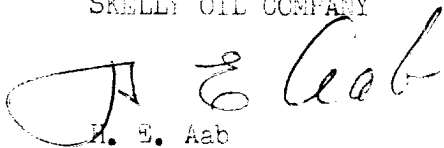
Dear Sir:

The 1961 deliverability test taken on the above subject well was 202 MCF gas per day, while the 1962 deliverability test was 243 MCF gas per day. The reason for this increase is that prior to the 1961 test the well was logging off with fluid. Since April 3, 1962 we have been blowing the well periodically to clear it out and as a result the deliverability test has increased.

We request the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission to change the allowable basis for this well to the 1962 deliverability test since this represents the deliverability according to production.
