Gentlemen:

The above subject well was shut in by order of the Oil Conservation Commission on July 1, 1961, for being 6 times overproduced. The 1960 deliverability test taken on this well was 45 MCF per day, while the 1961 deliverability test is 115 MCF per day. The reason for this increase is that prior to the 1960 test the well was logging off with fluid. Since then we have been blowing the well periodically to clean it cut and as a result the deliverability test has increased.

We request the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission to change the allowable basis for this well to the 1961 deliverability test since this represents the deliverability according to production. Effective date requested for this change is August 1, 1961, as the 1961 deliverability test was submitted July 25, 1961.
