

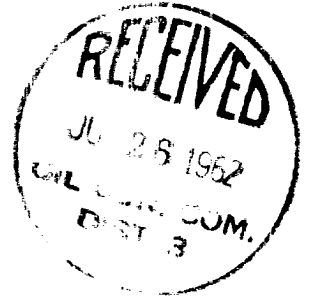

Dear Sir:

The 1961 deliverability test taken on the above subject well was 1265 MCF gas per day, while the 1962 deliverability test was 1277 MCF gas per day. The reason for this increase is that since the 1961 deliverability test the well was loading up with fluid. Since the 1962 test, the fluid has been cleaned out of the well and efficiency and as a result the deliverability test has increased.

We request the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission to change the allowable basis for this well to the 1962 deliverability test since this represents the deliverability according to production.
