Dear Mr. Spain:

Will you please file Federal Form 9331-A, Sundry Notice and Report on Wells, relative to the remedial work which was performed on the above well in 1966?

I have your letter of January 24, 1969, which states that damage occurred to the well head and stating that a packer had been run in the well.

The Sundry Notice filed should include the following information:

1. Any tests conducted to determine casing failure or to indicate the condition of the casing down hole.
2. The size and amount of tubing re-run in the hole and the type packer installed and the depth at which the packer was set.
3. Any other information on work performed which materially effects the present condition of the well.

The above report should be filed in quadruplicate with the United States Geological Survey Office in Farmington, New Mexico.
