Thank you for your letter of January 14. Our well was damaged in 1966 as a result of a truck driver of Plateau, Inc., running a crude truck over the Christmas tree of the well. Litigation did result from this accident.

Immediately after the accident, we notified the U. S. G. S. In conducting remedial work on the well, we did not want to take any chance of sticking the swab in the casing; consequently, we did run a packer in the well. I was unaware that it was necessary to file a report under these circumstances. Upon reflection, should you feel that a sundry notice is still needed by you under these circumstances, will you please inform me accordingly.
