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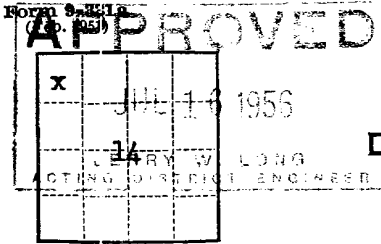

DETAILS OF WORK

Drilled 8 3/4" hole and reamed to 13 3/4" hole to 113' KB. Ran 9 5/8", 32.3#, H-40 Casing landed at 105' KB and cemented with 90 sax 2% CACL Cement. Casing equipped with Larkin Texas pattern Shoe and Float Collar. Pumped Plug to 90' KB with 600 PSI. Float held OK. Waited 24 hours, drilled out cement and tested surface casing with 500 PSI for 30 minutes. Held OK.
