Form C-126 must be filed in quadruplicate with the Proration Manager, Box 2045, Hobbs, New Mexico. Upon approval, one copy will be returned to the operator and one copy will be sent to the designated transporter as authority to transport the oil.

Definition of Recovered Load Oil:

Recovered load oil is any oil or liquid Hydrocarbon which has been used in any operation in an oil or gas well, and which has been recovered as a merchantable product.
