FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

Total depth of well is 5957'KB. All Logas have been run and all possible producing zones tested and none found to be productive. The following program will be followed in plugging this well.

Place cement plug from TD to approximately 5800', cement plug from 5750 to approximately 5650', cement plug from 5450 to approximately 5350', cement plug from 3350 to approximately 3150', cement plug from 2200 to approximately 2050', cement plug from 1300 to approximately 1150', cement plug from 500 to approximately 400', cement plug in top 25' of surface casing and erect marker in cement. Location will be levelled and cleaned as soon as drying up of pits will permit.

NOTE: The above outlined program was approved by Mr. P.T. McGrath, District Engineer of USGS, after examination of Logs run by Schlumberger.

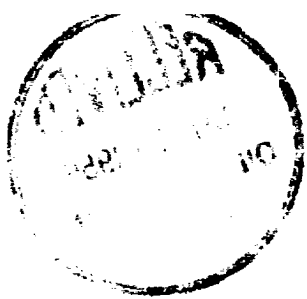
