DETAILS OF WORK

May 1, 1956. Reached total depth of 5957' KB, ran logs and completed tests of all possible producing zones and found none to be commercially productive.

Ran Drill Pipe open ended, spotted 60 sack cement from 10 to 5800', heavy mud to 5750', 40 sack cement from 5750 to 5645', heavy mud to 5450', 40 sack cement from 5450 to 5345', heavy mud to 3350', 80 sack cement from 3350 to 3140', heavy mud to 2200', 60 sack cement from 2200 to 2042', heavy mud to 1300', 60 sack cement from 1300 to 1142', heavy mud to 900', 40 sack cement from 900 to 395', heavy mud to 25' and 10 sack cement from 25' to ground level. Erected marker in cement and abandoned location.
