ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on March 11, 1959, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Daniel S. Nutter, Examiner duly appointed by the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission," in accordance with Rule 1214 of the Commission Rules and Regulations.

NOW, on this 11th day of March, 1959, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the application, the evidence adduced and the recommendations of the Examiner, Daniel S. Nutter, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That the applicant, British American Oil Producing Company, is the owner and operator of the Fullerton Well No. 3, located 860 feet from the North line and 1900 feet from the East line of Section 15, Township 37 North, Range 11 West, NEPM, San Juan County, New Mexico.
- (3) That the above-described well was drilled to the Dakota formation on an unorthodox location through good faith error.
- (4) That the applicant requests approval for said unorthodox location.
- (5) That no offset operator objected to the subject application.
- (6) That the subject application should be approved.

Butler, Examiner duly appointed by the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission", in accordance with Article 1114 of the Commission Rules and Regulations.

Now, on this 11th day of March, 1934, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the application, the evidence submitted and the recommendations of the Examiner, Walter E. Butler, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDINGS

- (1) That the public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That the applicant, British American Oil Refining Company, is the owner and operator of the Bullerton Well No. 1, located 650 feet from the North line and 1000 feet from the East line of Section 13, Township 32 North, Range 11 West, 20N2, 20E1, Juan County, New Mexico.
- (3) That the above-described well was drilled to the bottom formation as an exploratory location through good faith effort.
- (4) That the applicant requests approval for said well location.
- (5) That no other operator objected to the applicant's application.
- (6) That the subject application should be approved.
