30 minutes. Pressure held.

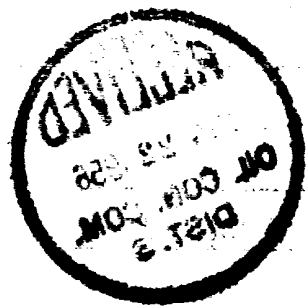
