It is proposed to drill this well with rotary tools to a depth sufficient to test the Dakota formation. Estimated total depth 6800'. Anticipated formations to be encountered are Gallup "A" at approximately 5900', Gallup "B" at approximately 5970', Gomerus at approximately 6175' and the Dakota at approximately 6550'.

8-5/8" OD Surface Casing will be set at approximately 350' and cemented from bottom to top with approximately 300 sk. cement. If productive zone is encountered 4-1/2" OD or 5-1/2" OD Casing will be run to TD and cemented with sufficient cement to protect all zones. Possible productive zone will be perforated, tested, treated if necessary, and well completed as single zone Basin Dakota gas well.

Item 1: If the proposal is to redrill to the same reservoir at a different subsurface location or to a new reservoir, use this form with appropriate notations. Consult applicable State or Federal regulations concerning subsequent work proposals or reports on the well.
