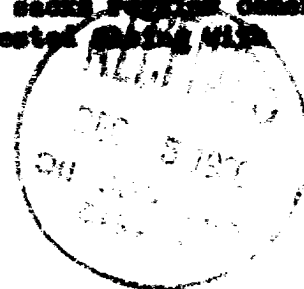

DETAILS OF WORK

Drilled 12-1/4" hole to 314' KB. Set 8-5/8" OD 24# J-55 Casing open ended at 290.46'. Total string 276.49'. Cemented with 250 sacks regular cement with 2% calcium chloride. Good returns to surface. Tested string with 500 psi for 30 minutes, Hold ok.
