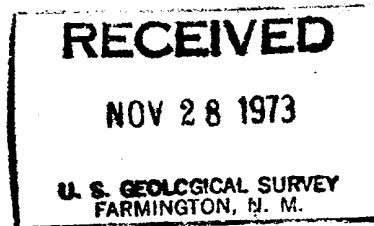

Moved in a service unit November 5, 1973, and cleaned out well to 2175'. Set 3-1/2" casing at 2175' with 200 sacks Class "A" cement with 6% Gel and 2 pounds medium Tuf Plug per sack followed by 50 sacks Class "A" Neat cement. Circulated cement. Circulated hole clean with 1% KCl water. Spotted 750 gallons 15% HCl on bottom and perforated interval 2131-49' with 2 SPF. Pumped 3500 gallon pad water with 1% KCl and 10 pounds Gel per 1000 gallons. Fraced with 50,000 gallons treated water, as above, 25,000 pounds 10-20 sand and 15,000 pounds 8-12 sand. Breakdown pressure 1600. Maximum treating pressure 2750, minimum 2650 and average 2700 psi. AIR 52 BPM. Cleaned out well to PBD 2155' and landed 1-1/4" tubing at 2130'. Flowed well to clean up and reconnected well to sales line. Production before repair 11 MCFD. Repair completed November 19, 1973 with production 226 MCFD.
