Your letter dated April 28, 1964 requested information pertaining to any wells in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 8-T24N-R12W or the S $\frac{1}{2}$  of Sec. 9-T27N-R12W, with special interest in Tidal #1.

There is not a well in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 8-T24N-R12W, and has never been anything filed with this office indicating that there was to be one in the future.

The Tidal #1 well, located 1705' from the S. line and 1160' from the E. line, has 160 acres dedicated to it and is operated by Laurence W. Ritter. The following information should bring you up to date on the status of this well; Spudded 1-15-60, Completed 7-22-60. 1st delivery was 9-13-60. As a producing gas well with an Initial Potential of 384 AOF and 358 MCF, the well was connected to El Paso Natural Gas Pipeline Company, but has been shut in by the state since 7-5-62, for failure to file production reports. This is the only well involved in the locations you inquired about.

oil wells in the SW of Sect. 1 - T2N-R10W or the SW of Sect. 1 - T2N-R10W  
is being forwarded to Tidal #1.

There is not a well in the SW of Sect. 1 - T2N-R10W, and has never  
been anything filed with this office. Because that there was no be  
ing in the future.

The Tidal #1 well, located 1907' from the N. 1/4 and 1160' from the  
E. line, has 100 acres dedicated to it and is operated by Lawrence W. Brown.  
The following information should bring you up to date on the status of this  
well: Operator 1-11-60, Completed 7-22-60. It delivered 100-12-60. As a  
production well with an initial potential of 384 AWT and 308 MCF, the  
well was connected to El Paso Natural Gas Pipeline Company, but has been  
shut in by the state since 7-2-60, for failure to file a production report.  
This is the only well involved in the location you have asked about.
