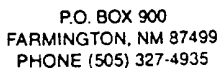

Part IV - Process used to return well to production.

The subject well was drilled and completed in 1960. It produced from the Pictured Cliffs sand until approximately July 2, 1962 at which time the State OCD ordered the well shut-in for failure to file production reports. Apparently Tidal Oil Company entered bankruptcy in January 1962 and reports were not filed. To our knowledge the well was not produced from 1962 until our recent work. The BLM canceled the original lease effective May 31, 1986. Roddy Production Company, Inc (RPC) and it's partners purchased the lease at a BLM sale January 17, 1996. Since that time we have secured NAPI and BLM approval to re-enter the well and return it to production.

On April 10, 1997 RPC began the process to return the well to production. The well was re-perforated and re-fraced in the prior Pictured Cliffs interval. The well was tested and turned into the pipeline April 23, 1997.
