Dear Sir:

The first step of the annual packer leakage test is scheduled to commence June 30, 1964 for our Fullerton No. 6. The upper zone has been abandoned since January 10, 1962; therefore, we propose to deviate from the normal test procedure. During the 1963 test there was some question as to whether or not the packer was holding. Your letter to British-American dated September 4, 1963 requested further tests in order that a definite determination could be made.

Our proposed packer leakage test is as you suggested in your letter as follows: shut-in both zones for a minimum of 7 days and take dead weight pressures. Flow the upper zone to the atmosphere for a 3 hour period and tabulate the lower zone pressure at 15 minute intervals.

If this meets with your approval we will take the test in place of the normal packer leakage test; however, if not please advise.
