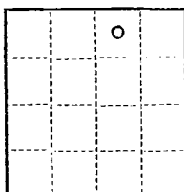

DETAILS OF WORK

The designated drilling unit is the NE/4 of Section 12.

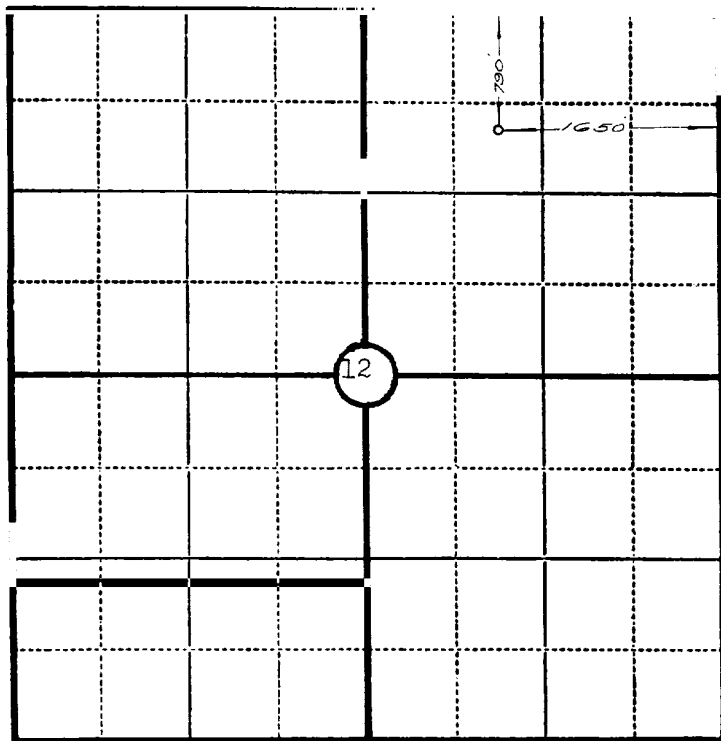
