(5) That the applicant further seeks an unorthodox Dakota gas well location for said Section C. Schlosser Federal Well No. 1.

(6) That approval of the subject application will not cause waste.

(7) That approval of the subject application will not impair correlative rights since the proposed unorthodox Dakota gas well location will stand only affecting acreage owned and operated by the applicant, and the royalty on the two tracts is also common.

IX. NO. THREE ORDERED:


That the applicant be and the same is hereby authorized to duly complete the Section C. Schlosser Federal Well No. 1 at an unorthodox location 790 feet from the North line and 1900 feet from the West line of Section 10, Township 17 North, Range 11 West, DOUG, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of oil from an undesignated Gallego pool and the production of gas from an undesignated Dakota pool through parallel strings of 2-3/8 inch CO tubing.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Sect. V, Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the Dakota producing interval pool.

X. NO. FOURTH ORDERED:

That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained by the Commission for such further order or orders as may seem necessary or convenient for the prevention of waste and/or protection of correlative rights; upon failure of applicant to comply with any requirement of this order, after proper notice and hearing the Commission may terminate the authority hereby granted and require applicant or its successors and assigns to limit its activities to regular single-zone production in the interests of conservation.
