DETAILS OF WORK

This well drilled to a total depth of 7763 feet, Ignacio sand, with rotary tools. Landed 705' of 13 3/8" OD, at 722', -cemented with 500 sax - 4724' of 9 5/8" OD, at 4679', cemented with 300 sax - 7822' of 7" OD, at 7762', cemented with 500 sax. Perforated 7450-80, 7453-78, 7483-92 - 7502-08, 7511-17, 7523-33. 2 7/8" EUE tubing landed at 7523. On 24 hour test well produced as follows: 38/64" choke, tubing pressure 1060#, gas rate 9,100 M. cuft., oil production 190 bbls., BS&W 17 bbls. (flowing) Test completed 1-10-51.
