## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Well was shut in for a period of 7 days, and on June 28, 1955 tests showed shut in pressures as follows:

Casing 1143 psig. Tubing 2025 psig

thus indicating no casing leaks have developed since the well was originally completed.

This well was formerly known as Byrd Oil Corporation-Christine Hughes No. 2, and was the subject of application by J. Glenn Turner, present Operator, on August 3, 1955 to produce the well from both the Dakota Formation and the Mesa Verde Formation, which application was approved on August 5, 1955 by Commission Order No. DC-219.

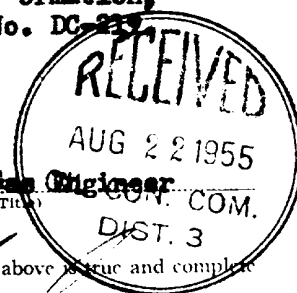
