Today it was called to my attention that no Gas Well Plat had been filed on the above well.


Accordingly, I am sending you herewith, in triplicate, a Gas Well Plat dated August 19, 1955, the same date as my letter and the Form C-103 and Form C-104 transmitted at that time.

You will note, however, that the well is in Unit "N" inasmuch as it is located 750 feet from the south line and 2320 feet from the west line. Form C-110 and previous references have shown the well as Unit "M" as at that time I was under the impression that the well was closer to the corner of the section.

I shall appreciate it if you will make the necessary corrections on the other papers on file.

You will note that the west half of section 3 has been dedicated to this well which has been completed in both the Mesa Verde and the Dakota Formations.
